"Honour the Lord with thy substance, and with the first fruits of all thine increase: So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine." Proverbs 3:9-10

First Fruits refers to the first portion of the harvest

that is given to God. Most notably the first fruits are:

- The first to come in time
- The best
- A pledge or hope of the greater harvest to follow
- Specially dedicated to God.

A First Fruits ceremony is described in detail in Deuteronomy 26:1-11

We are no longer agricultural farmers, so our *fruit* is what we do, produce or recieve. Our work product is converted into income and/or money. This is what we offer unto God.

Example: If a person makes or receives \$24,000 a year income that would be equivalent to:

\$2000.00 Monthly (Yearly Income divided by 12 months)

\$462.00 Weekly (Yearly income divided by 52 weeks)

\$93.00 Daily (Yearly income divided by 260 days- based on a 5 day work week.)

If you are this person and you vowed to pledge a weeks income, your First Fruit offering would be \$462.00.
